As part of your personalized treatment plan, your physician has prescribed a compounded medication to help manage your **hair condition**. Compounding is the process of preparing customized medications by combining, mixing, or altering ingredients to meet the unique needs of individual patients.

These medications often include a combination of two or more active ingredients and are typically formulated as topical creams, gels, or ointments. Compounded medications are especially beneficial for patients who have allergies or sensitivities to certain dyes, preservatives, or other components found in commercially available drugs. They may also be prescribed when an FDA-approved medication is not suitable or available for a patient's specific medical condition.

Using your compounded medication is as easy as 1-2-3

1. Shake well

- **Shake well before each use:** This ensures the medication is properly mixed for accurate dosing. Some settling is normal during shipping or periods of non-use.

2. Know your dose

- Read the dosing instructions on the prescription label.
- **For dropper bottles:** Before removing the dropper, squeeze the bulb a few times while it is still inside the bottle to ensure proper mixing. Then, dispense the amount directed by your provider onto the affected area. Rinse off as instructed.
- **For shampoo bottles:** Apply only the amount of medication directed by your provider to the affected area. Lather if instructed, then rinse off as directed.

3. Stay Calm and Follow Your Treatment Plan

- Managing your condition takes time – be patient, stay consistent, and reach out if you have any questions or concerns.
- Due to the nature of the condition, it may take several months of consistent use to see noticeable results. While using our hair product(s), be sure to apply it exactly as directed and avoid missing doses or applications to ensure the best possible outcome.
- It's normal for hair to appear worse before it improves – this can occur due to the natural hair growth cycle and how follicles respond to treatment.

Use this medication exactly as prescribed by your doctor, including the specified dose and frequency.

Applying more or less than directed may affect the effectiveness of your treatment.
